GEORGE HARRISON HEAD




INSTRUCTIONS

Making this paper model is easy! There's no need for glue, all you need is a craft knife and a surface to cut on. Remember, be very careful when using the knife! Children, you must get an adult to help you! This page will create the head, once this is finished you can move onto the body.


- 1 Ok, using the craft knife, cut along all the solid white lines, leave the dotted parts intact.

Then softly score along the dotted lines, make sure not to cut through the paper on these sections.




- 2 You should now be able to separate the model from the page.

Fold the paper at right angles along all of the dotted lines.




- 3 Notice it fall into a cube shape.


Fold and insert the tabs into the corresponding slots in the flaps to fix the cube into shape. The indication colours should match on both sides.



- 4 Now to finish off, cut out the tuft of hair below and insert it into the slot on the top of the head so that it sticks out the top.



Your model should now look something like this...



- 5 Well done, the head is now complete!

Once you've made the body, you should find that the head fits neatly on top.
